As the Member of Parliament for Cowichan-Malahat-Langford, I know full well the negative impact that Brock's crime has had on Christopher and his family, and I am pleased to offer my wholehearted support to the Ducharme family's requests.

I understand that the family are requesting stipulations to Brock's potential day parole, including, but not limited to:

- Electronic monitoring device
- Prohibited contact with victim's family
- Prohibited from entering Alberta or BC, where the victim's family currently resides
- Prohibited from alcohol and illegal drug consumption
- Strict nightly curfews

Due to the actions of Brock Graham, Christopher and his family have already suffered an unimaginable tragedy. The prospect of Brock's granted parole understandably renews the deep sorrow associated with the loss of Patricia Ducharme.

As such, should day parole be granted, it is my hope that the PBC will take into account and respect the wishes of the Ducharme family.
